Introduction

God has given me a vision regarding the circumstances in your life and I have a special message for you:

THIS IS YOUR TURNING POINT. This is it, beloved! I declare it!

For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.

(Mark 11:23)

He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches.

(Revelation 3:6)

In the midst of your financial crisis...your family relationships...unsaved children and loved ones...in the midst of your sickness and disease...God will perform a miracle that will be the turning point in your life.

God has heard your cries and has seen your tears. He has not been unmindful of your pain and suffering. Now, it is time for you to rejoice!

This is your harvest time to receive a miracle that will TURN your life around.

This is your harvest time to receive the answers you have been patiently awaiting...to enter into a new dimension of victorious living that far surpasses anything that you have ever dreamed would be possible.

But as it is written, Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love him.

But God hath revealed them unto us by his Spirit: for the Spirit searcheth all things, yea, the deep things of God.

(I Corinthians 2:9-10)

God is going to reveal to you the unsearchable riches of His glory. He has put His Spirit within you, and within that Spirit is the potential **to receive** the things that God has prepared, the unsearchable riches of Christ, that the eye has not seen nor the ear heard. These unsearchable riches were kept hidden until the fullness of time. These riches and the mystery of Christ were revealed to the Apostle Paul and he preached among the Gentiles.

Somehow the Church lost sight of these riches and how it is possible for us to obtain them. But, praise the Name of the living God, in these last days God is making known unto us the mystery, the hidden wisdom of God, the unsearchable riches of His glory.

Even the mystery which hath been hid from ages and from generations, but now is made manifest to his saints: To whom God would make known what is the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; which is Christ in you, the hope of glory:

(Colossians 1:26-27)

Not only are these hidden riches being revealed to us through the revelation knowledge of God that is pouring forth, we are going to EXPERIENCE the fullness of these riches.

Friends, it's harvest time!

God moves in cycles. Within this harvest-time cycle, certain manifestations are going to take place. A revelation of the unsearchable riches of God is one of

them.

But, beloved, God has revealed to me in a vision something which must take place in your life **before** you can experience the fullness of His riches.

You Must Have a Turning Point!

The potential is within you to receive but something has hindered you from receiving. God wants to remove that hindrance and turn your circumstances around. Even now I believe He is working in your life to bring you to a specific decisive point in His great plan for your life so that you will be able to **receive** and be enabled to accomplish what He has called you to do in these last days.

Before I share with you the vision God gave me concerning your turning point, I want you to remember with me the vision I shared with you in October of 1982.

In a night vision, God showed me two hands...the enemy's hands...holding your life (like a towel) trying to wring out every particle of life...every ounce of strength. God told me the devil was going to do everything possible to wring out your spiritual life...to come against you...to come against your family...your finances...to come against you in the circumstances of your life.

The message He gave me for you then was:

Don't give up-it's harvest time. I have seen your tears...I have heard your cries.

He said, "Let them know that I have been mindful of the fact that they have stood on My Word and they have believed My promises in spite of the circumstances...in spite of the difficulties...in spite of the fact that on the surface it appears that I have not been faithful in answering prayer nor in keeping My Word."

Now God Has Given Me Another Message for You

"Tell My people:

"I have heard their cries, I have seen how they have hung on to My Word...tell them I am going to answer their prayers. "

Once again God has spoken to me in a vision and has revealed what He is going to do for you.

In this vision, I saw two great big hands from heaven coming out of the sky and they were dipped into a raging sea filled with people. The sea was very

stormy and billowing and I saw those hands going down into that sea and picking up those people and turning those lives around. God spoke to me and said:

"Son, it's harvest time. This is My people's turning point. I am going to literally reach down into the ravages of the sea of life and pick up lives and turn them around. "

BEFORE, I SAW SATAN'S HANDS AND WHAT HE WAS TRYING TO DO TO YOU. THIS TIME, I SAW GOD'S BIG, STRONG HANDS INTERVENING IN THE MIDST OF SATAN'S RAGING AND TURNING YOUR LIFE ... YOUR CIRCUMSTANCES ... AROUND!

This is God's promise to us...to you and me.

Praise God! God wants to turn your life around. He wants to TURN your sorrow into joy. He will TURN your enemies from before you until they will be amazed and fear will be upon them.

He wants to turn your fear into courage, your weakness into strength. He will turn your doubts into faith and your eyes will begin to see things you have never seen before. This is your turning point!

This is God's timing for you. No longer do you have to continue walking down the road of fear, frustration, and defeat. God is going to lift you up, turn you around, and set your feet on a new path that is going to lead you into a greater relationship with Him, until the unsearchable riches of Christ are going to come pouring forth from your innermost being. Your life is going to be changed, transformed, renewed. Family relationships are going to be healed. Your loved ones are going to be saved. Your financial needs are going to be met, your broken heart is going to be mended.

So, child of God, don't lose hope. Don't give up. God has not forgotten nor forsaken you. You are safe within His hands and He is **turning** your life around.

Chapter One

"BROTHER CERULLO, What do you mean when you refer to a turning point?"

Webster defines "turning point" as "a point at which a significant change occurs." You and I have experienced various turning points in our lives.

A definite turning point in my life was the night in the Jewish Orthodox orphanage when God supernaturally intervened as I was ready to take my life.

While in bed one night, overwhelmed with my failure of the past and with no hope for anything better, the suggestion came to me...an eight year old boy...to end it all —commit suicide. There seemed to be nothing left for which to live. This was the devil's last attempt to keep me from the Lord.

I made my way down the long hall to the washroom from which I would jump. I turned for one last look down the hall, then entered the bathroom. Seeing that all was clear, I threw open the window.

My heart throbbed when I looked at the pavement below. Lowering my body for the final spring, I took one last deep breath. At that second my heart stopped throbbing. I felt an unusual Presence. Thinking someone had entered the washroom I gave a quick glance behind me. Although I saw no one, I knew I was not alone.

Something was happening to me but I did not know what. The atmosphere all around me seemed to speak peace. Gazing upward I saw the beautiful stars and moon with all their brightness and glory, shining. It all spoke of quietness and peace. I just stared at the heavens. My eyes seemed to be paralyzed by the stars and the moon.

At this great moment I felt a peculiar sensation from the crown of my head to the soles of my feet. It went all through my body. My anxious soul was strangely calmed; my fears allayed.

Now I knew I was not alone. Unconsciously I found myself getting back inside the washroom, my eyes fixed upward, my heart greatly calmed by the Presence of Another. No longer distressed, no longer despondent, I made my way down the hall toward my room.

Awaking early the next morning, I wondered how, why, what? By rights I should be dead, but instead I was alive and feeling wonderful. Little did I know, that turning point in my life was just the beginning of what God was going to do in and through me as I yielded myself to Him.

For many are called, but few are chosen

(Matthew 22:14)

Since that time I have experienced other turning points which have all been within God's plan for my life. I am sure you can also think back in your life and see various turning points which changed the direction in which you were headed.

The greatest turning point in our lives is when we meet

Christ at Calvary and He turns our lives around. The Apostle Paul experienced a very dramatic turning point in his life on the road to Damascus (Acts 9:1-17). He was turned completely around...from a life of persecuting Christians, he began a life of building and strengthening the Church.

We are dealing with a very specific turning point which involves the promises of God you have been believing Him for and have been waiting to see manifest in your life.

This turning point involves the battles you are facing right now...your finances...your family...your sickness...the circumstances in your life. Satan has brought these circumstances into your life to defeat you and turn you away from God. Now God is going to take those same problems and circumstances, He is going to **turn them around** and show Himself strong on your behalf.

There is a man with whom you are well acquainted in the Bible who experienced the type of turning point you are going to experience. Most often he is associated with persecution and suffering. Today I want you to see him from a different viewpoint.

Job's Turning Point

We emphasize the sufferings of Job but often fail to point out how God not only sustained him during his trials but that God **TURNE**D around the circumstances in his life and **DOUBLED** his blessings.

And the LORD TURNED the captivity of Job, when he prayed for his friends: also the LORD gave Job twice (DOUBLE) as much as he had before.

(Job 42:10)

Job's blessings...

Before	After
7,000 sheep	14,000 sheep
3,000 camels	6,000 camels
500 yoke of oxen	1,000 yoke of oxen
500 she asses	1,000 she asses
7 sons	7 sons
3 daughters	3 beautiful daughters

In addition to all these blessings, God gave him a long life and he lived to see four generations of his sons and daughters.

God has revealed to me that in the days to come He is going to double the blessings in the lives of His people.

God did not place any restrictions or boundaries for this doubling. There is no limit to what God will do for you. In fact, God is waiting to do for you more than what you are even able to think or to ask, according to the power that He has placed within you (Ephesians 3:20).

The prophet Isaiah prophesied concerning the doubling that would come upon God's people in the last days:

But you shall be called the priests of the Lord; people will speak of you as the ministers of our God.

You shall eat the wealth of the nations, and the glory (once that of your captors) shall be yours. For your (former) shame you shall have a twofold recompense; instead of dishonor and reproach your people shall rejoice in their portion; therefore in their land they shall possess double (what they had forfeited); everlasting joy shall be theirs.

(Isaiah 61:6-7, ANT)

Also Zechariah prophesied:

Turn you to the stronghold (of security and prosperity), you prisoners of hope; even today do I

declare that I will restore double your former prosperity to you...And the Lord their God will save them on that day as the flock of His people, for they

shall be as the (precious) jewels of a crown, lifted high over and shining glitteringly upon His land.

(Zechariah 9:12,16, ANT)

Many of you can identify with Job's sufferings. Job was being tossed in a turbulent sea that was filled with every type of disaster imaginable. He faced financial ruin, lost his children, and his health was gone.

Some of you are facing financial difficulties and have exhausted every means of recourse. The waves of fear and frustration seem to engulf you.

Some of you are facing family problems with your children, with unsaved loved ones. You feel as if you are in the middle of an ocean, you are struggling to survive, and there seems to be no help in sight.

Others of you have experienced heartbreak. Your lives have been torn apart through divorce. The storm is howling around you and you are almost ready to give up hope.

And then there are those of you who feel as if you are drowning in a sea of physical suffering and disease. Many are at the point where you have suffered so long, like Job, you almost wish God would take you home.

There was a certain point, a decisive change in Job's life that **set in motion** God's doubling principle in his life.

The Word does not make clear the amount of time involved before Job enjoyed the benefits of the double blessings God poured out upon him. I do not believe Job experienced an instantaneous miracle or an instantaneous doubling, but I believe God gently and lovingly **turned** Job's life around until He had restored double all that he had lost.

Are you ready for a miracle? You have already identified with Job's sufferings, are you ready now to identify with the doubling Job experienced?

Chapter Two

"BROTHER CERULLO, How can I experience this turning point in my life?"

Through the revelation knowledge of God that is pouring through me right now, I can sense there are many of you who are beginning to see, to catch a glimpse of that new dimension that God wants to bring you into. You have listened to what the Spirit of the Lord is saying through His prophet. You have said, "If only I could enter into this revelation...this new dimension... I need a turning point in my life. I am so hungry to receive from God...I am at the point of desperation..! do not know what to do or who to turn to."

There are others of you who desperately want to believe but who are thinking, "It is too good to be true." "It all sounds good, but how can I relate to something so rich and so wonderful as you have described?" "My life is filled with heartache, frustrations, and seemingly endless defeats. It would take a miracle!"

Some of you are wondering: "How am I going to get from the point where I am...at a point of frustration, fear, turmoil, sickness, broken relationships, heartache...to the point where God wants me to be in these last days?"

The answer to your question lies in the blessed truth that **your heavenly Father knows exactly where you are.**

He knows your heartaches. He has seen your tears.

He knows all your failures and shortcomings, and yet in His great love and compassion He is working even now within your life. He knows exactly what it will take, the miracles that you will need in order for Him to turn your life around. He has a plan just for you. God's Word says, "The steps of a good man are ordered by the LORD" (Psalm 37:23).

Before you can have a turning point in your life, you must have a clear understanding of how God deals with His children. You must renew your confidence in your heavenly Father, that He is in control and that He will gently lead you to a relationship in Him where you can EXPERIENCE those unsearchable riches and glory that He has prepared for you.

I pray that as you read God will open your spiritual eyes, by His revelation power, and anoint your mind:

To grant you a glimpse into the loving heart of our Father...

To reveal to you, by His Holy Spirit, His unlimited abilities...

To enable you to comprehend what He earnestly desires and longs to bestow upon you.

See the Loving Heart of Our Father

I am firmly convinced that man with his finite mind has not yet been able to comprehend the vastness of the great love that God has poured out upon mankind.

In the Word of God, from the very first book of Genesis through the last book, the book of Revelation, we see example after example of God's unfailing, unchanging love as He patiently deals with man, as He protects him from his enemies, as He disciplines him. In fact, the main theme of the Bible is God's love.

Yet, with all the examples and scriptures contained in the Word of God, God's people have not been able to see clearly into the full dimension of the unsearchable riches of His love. We need a breakthrough. We need a new revelation...we need the veil of darkness to be lifted from our eyes so that we can see into the loving heart of our Father and enter into a deeper relationship with Him.

*Hereby perceive we the love of God, because he laid down his life for us...
(I John 3:16)*

The only way we can understand and know the love of God is to look at the sacrifice, the ultimate sacrifice, that God made for us.

Have you ever stopped to realize that even before God created man, and placed him in the Garden of Eden, He knew that man would sin and that it would be necessary for Him to give His only begotten Son as a sacrifice to redeem fallen man and to bring him back into full fellowship with Him?

Knowing that man would sin and rebel against Him, God formulated a plan. And, according to His Word He has "saved us, and called us with an holy calling, not according to our works, but **according to His own purpose** and grace, which was given us in Christ Jesus **before the world began**" (II Timothy 1:9).

According to Peter, we are God's elect "**according to the foreknowledge of God**" (I Peter 1.2).

The Apostle Paul, in writing to Titus, mentions the hope of eternal life which God promised **before the world began** (Titus 1:2).

Knowing that man would turn his back upon Him, our Father willingly sent His Son into the world to suffer, to bleed and die.

Are you beginning to see the great love God had for us even before the world began?

Within the heart of God there was a yearning, a longing for fellowship...for someone who would worship and love Him. Even though there were thousands of angels, His created beings, who worshipped Him around His throne, there was a desire within His heart for an intimate, personal relationship with a being who would willingly love and worship Him.

And so God formed man from the dust of the earth. He made him in His own image. But it was not until God breathed into man that man became a living soul. As God breathed the breath of life into Adam, he became more than a creation...he possessed the life-sustaining force of God Almighty.

God placed within Adam a desire and a longing for fellowship with Him and He communed with Adam during the cool of the day (Genesis 3:8). But the day came when man turned his back on God. He broke the fellowship, the intimate communion with God. How it grieved the heart of the Father to cast Adam and Eve out of the Garden of Eden.

Yet, He kept on loving. He would not be denied the fellowship that He so longed and desired. And, according to His foreordained plan, God sent His only begotten Son so that fellowship...that love He desired...would be fulfilled through many sons and daughters who would be born into His family as a result of His sacrifice.

For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

(John 3:16)

But when the fulness of the time was come, God sent forth his Son, made of a woman, made under the law, To redeem them that were under the law, that we might receive the adoption of sons. And because ye are sons,

God hath sent forth the Spirit of his Son into your hearts, crying, Abba,

Father.

(Galatians 4:4-6)

The Apostle John, also known as 'John the beloved,' received a revelation of God's great love and the sonship relationship. He said:

Behold, what manner of love the Father hath bestowed upon us, that we should be called the sons of God...

(I John 3:1)

With this same great love God reaches out to you today. He sees the circumstances you face. He has seen you during the nights you have called out to Him in despair. And, His heart is grieved when you have become fearful and doubt His loving care and concern for you. He is calling you to a closer communion with Him. He wants you to abide in His love.

One of Satan's primary tactics is to cause you to doubt God's love. He knows that if he is successful in getting you to doubt His love for you, that you will not be able to stand during the time of testing and trial.

After he has brought pain, disease, suffering, heartache and turmoil into your life Satan says: "If God loves you so much, why doesn't He deliver you?" "Why would He allow this to happen to you?"

Once you become firmly established in this new love relationship with the Father, you will experience a strength you never imagined possible. You will be able to say with confidence:

"You are a liar, Satan! My Father loves me and I have confidence in Him that He is working all things for my good. Get out of my way, Satan! There is nothing...absolutely NOTHING...you can do to me that can remove me out of His hands. I refuse to listen to your garbage. I know my Father intimately, and He knows me. I cast out all fear in the Name of Jesus and I am going to rest safe and secure in Him."

I have news for Satan. The revelation knowledge of God is upon us. God is at work within you right now filling you with the warmth of His powerful Presence. And by the power of His Holy Spirit within you, you are going to go beyond the regions of your natural mind and in the Spirit you are going to touch the heart of God and know beyond the shadow of any doubt that God loves you with an everlasting love and is longing...He is waiting...to comfort and strengthen you.

God's love does not waiver. Our love is fickle at times but His love is steadfast and sure. Because of Adam's sin, we do not possess God's love when we are born into this world. But, the love of God has been given to us by the power of the Holy Spirit (Romans 5:5).

God wants us to abide in His love so that we may be able to cast out all fear:

And we have known and believed the love that God hath to us. God is love; and he that dwelleth in love dwelleth in God, and God in him. Herein is our love made perfect, that we may have boldness in the day of judgment: because as he is, so are we in this world. There is no fear in love; but perfect love casteth out fear: because fear hath torment. He that feareth is not made perfect in love.

(I John 4:16-18)

Regardless of the situations you face in your life, when you are abiding in God's love you can cast aside that fear in the Name of Jesus, confident that your Father is going to turn your circumstances around.

God loves you so much, He is just waiting for you to call upon Him. He longs to show Himself strong on your behalf.

For the eyes of the LORD run to and fro throughout the whole earth, to shew himself strong in the behalf of them whose heart is perfect toward him...

(II Chronicles 16:9)

The righteous cry, and the LORD heareth, and delivereth them out of all their troubles... Many are the afflictions of the righteous: but the LORD delivereth him out of them all... The LORD redeemeth the soul of his servants: and none of them that trust in him shall be desolate.

(Psalm 34:17,19,22)

Beloved, when you are abiding in God's love there is nothing...no power on earth...no circumstances...that can snatch you out of the hands of your loving Father:

For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

(Romans 8:38-39)

I would like to share a true story with you which I believe illustrates, to a small degree, the love God has for His children.

This story involves one of the greatest men who ever lived. His name was Abraham Lincoln and the story takes place in the White House during the years of his presidency.

One day, outside President Lincoln's office, sat a very important member of his cabinet and a general, waiting to have a word with the president. They had a specific appointment to see him. The president was extremely busy, and as they waited outside, their appointment was delayed. They were becoming a little bit irate because they were having to wait so long.

Suddenly a little boy walked past the appointment secretary, looked at the general, looked at the cabinet member, smiled and opened the door to the president's office and walked right in.

About 20 minutes later, old, tall, lanky Abraham Lincoln came out of his office with his arm around this little boy, patted him on the head, kissed him on the forehead, and the little boy ran off. The big general stood up and said, "Mr. Lincoln, I have never been so insulted in all my life. I don't mind waiting, which I have been for such a long time, and my appointment with you is long overdue. But, this little boy walked past the secretary and didn't say a word, walked right past us, opened the door and walked right inside to see you. Aren't you ashamed to allow that to happen when we were forced to sit out here and wait?"

Abraham Lincoln looked at that general with that quiet unassuming manner of his and said, "Sir, don't be so hard on me. That little boy was my son."

Right now close your eyes and look into the loving heart of the Father Who stands patiently waiting, longing for you to call upon Him, to love Him, to worship Him. He never sleeps nor slumbers (Psalm 121:4). His eyes are upon you. His ears are attentive to your cry.

As you look into the loving heart of your Father, in the Name of Jesus I say unto you:

Receive a new vision, a new revelation of His loving concern for you.

See His Unlimited Abilities

As I have said many times before, man limits an unlimited God. Therefore,

before we can take the limits off God and allow Him to turn our circumstances around, we must have a revelation...the veil must be lifted off our minds.

So often when we face distressing circumstances, we have preconceived ideas as to how and what God should do for us even before we ask Him for help.

We must have a renewed mind to be able to see His unlimited abilities. Many times we settle for less than what God wants to give us because we are impatient and because we have not allowed our minds to go beyond their natural limitations into the Spirit.

We see a perfect example of this in the feeding of the four thousand:

Then Jesus called his disciples unto him, and said, I have compassion on the multitude, because they continue with me now three days, and have nothing to eat: and I will not send them away fasting, lest they faint in the way. And his disciples say unto him, Whence should we have so much bread in the wilderness, as to fill so great a multitude?

(Matthew 15:32-33)

The disciples were limiting the power of God to meet the need of the hour because they did not really see Jesus as the powerful Son of God. They could only see through their natural mind their own limited natural resources of seven loaves and a few fish. Even though they had already witnessed the feeding of the five thousand on another occasion, they had not experienced a breakthrough from the natural mind into the spiritual mind of God.

The Apostle Peter caught a glimpse of Jesus and his unlimited abilities one night in the middle of a stormy, billowing sea. For a moment he entered into a new dimension of power which took him beyond his physical limitations as he saw Christ in His fullness.

I am sure this story is familiar to you but I want you to focus your attention on two important truths:

1. There is a new level of power for you that is beyond your natural limitations.

2. Keep your eyes on our unlimited God.

... And when Peter was come down out of the ship, he walked on the water, to go to Jesus.

(Matthew 14:29)

In this verse, Peter was not functioning according to his natural limitations. According to the natural mind it was impossible for Peter to be able to walk on the water. But, Peter had His eyes on the unlimited abilities of Christ and for a few moments he broke through the natural realm into a spiritual realm and he began to do the impossible, Peter walked on the water! But, something happened:

...when he saw the wind boisterous, he was afraid; and beginning to sink, he cried, saying, Lord, save me.

And immediately Jesus stretched forth his hand, and caught him, and said unto him, O thou of little faith, wherefore didst thou doubt?

(Matthew 14:30-31)

Peter took his eyes off Jesus and when He did, he immediately fell back into the natural realm and his natural reasoning took control. He began to focus his eyes on the storm and began to sink.

God has shown me that some of you have allowed your circumstances ... problems with rebellious children...financial problems...health problems...to literally control you. You are still looking to your own limited resources and you need a breakthrough. God wants you to enter into a spiritual realm where you will be able to do the impossible and see the impossible happen in your life as you draw from His unlimited sources.

He has placed within you the power to do the impossible! The things we consider impossible in the natural are possible when we are operating in the spiritual realm. He is going to use **you** to take those impossibilities into the spiritual world where all things are possible! ...with God *all* things are possible.

(Matthew 19:26)

Praise God, He is going to do "exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us" (Ephesians 3:20).

In the vision God gave me, I saw people who, like Peter, were beginning to sink in the raging sea. Some of you have almost given up hope. The circumstances in your life have made you fearful and you feel as if you are going to sink.

Just as Jesus responded to Peter as he began to sink, He is reaching down into the turmoil that surrounds you and is lifting you into a place of safety.

Right now I believe He is working within you...lifting you out of the

natural realm of impossibilities into the spiritual realm where God's **unlimited** abilities can turn your seemingly impossible situations completely around.

See What He Earnestly Desires for You

As you begin to walk daily in this spiritual realm and draw upon His unlimited abilities He has placed within you, you are going to discover the riches, the power, the glory God has prepared, waiting for you. My prayer for you is...

... that he might make known the riches of his glory on the vessels of mercy, which he had afore prepared unto glory, Even us, whom he hath called, not of the Jews only, but also of the Gentiles,..

(Romans 9:23-24)

Beloved, many of you may be so burdened down by the cares of this life that the only goal you have before you is "survival." God wants you to have much more than what you have now. God wants you to enjoy and partake of the riches He has prepared for you.

I believe this is God's hour for the Church to rise up and possess their inheritance. God has restored our fellowship with Him, through the blood of Jesus, and we are His children. We are joint-heirs with Christ...today! Right now!

And because ye are sons, God hath sent forth the Spirit of his Son into your hearts, crying, Abba, Father. Wherefore thou art no more a servant, but a son; and if a son, then an heir of God through Christ.

(Galatians 4:6-7)

You do not have to wait until you get to heaven to possess your inheritance.

Oh, how it blesses the heart of our Father for Him to see you and me beginning to appropriate His riches in our lives. Turn your eyes away from your circumstances...your surroundings...your failures...see the riches He has prepared for you:

His wisdom

Howbeit we speak wisdom among them that are perfect: yet not the wisdom of this world, nor of the princes of this world, that come to nought: But we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery, even the hidden wisdom, which God ordained before the world unto our glory:

(I Corinthians 2:6-7)

Before the world began, God planned for you to partake of the riches of His wisdom. He wants you to operate in the realm of His wisdom instead of being ruled by your natural mind. He wants you to stop leaning to your own understanding.

His joy

These things have I spoken unto you, that my joy might remain in you, and that your joy might be full.

(John 15:11)

And the ransomed of the LORD shall return, and come to Zion with songs and everlasting joy upon their heads: they shall obtain joy and gladness, and sorrow and sighing shall flee away.

(Isaiah 35:10)

We are living in a day of restoration and God wants you to have the riches of His joy. His joy far surpasses man's joy.

It is not dependent upon whether or not the bills are paid....

It is not dependent upon the condition of your health...

It is not dependent upon the good or bad circumstances you face.

God's joy is another one of His unsearchable riches He is going to manifest to His children in this harvest-time cycle. He wants you to have His joy within you **during** your trials because "the joy of the LORD is your strength" (Nehemiah 8:10).

This is your turning point. He is going to turn your sorrow into joy.

His peace

These things I have spoken unto you, that in me ye might have peace. In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world.

(John 16:33)

And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

(Philippians 4:7)

In the midst of the storms in your life, God wants you to have a peace...not ordinary peace that is based on what you see with your natural eyes...but a peace that transcends the natural mind and goes into that spiritual realm.

Praise God, He is going to remove the turmoil, anxiety and worry in your life and replace it with **His peace**.

His rest

Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.

(Matthew 11:28)

For we which have believed do enter into rest, as he said, As I have sworn in my wrath, if they shall enter into my rest: although the works were finished from the foundation of the world.

(Hebrews 4:3)

Your heavenly Father is calling you into a place of rest. He has provided a place of joy, peace and safety for you in time of trouble. This is part of the inheritance that belongs to you.

By faith open your eyes and see the riches God wants you to have...

By faith believe they belong to you as a joint-heir with Christ...

By faith begin to appropriate them in your life.

Chapter Three

"BROTHER CERULLO, How does God deal with His children?"

Have you ever stopped to wonder about the millions upon millions of sons and daughters that God has brought into His family? Each one of His children are precious in His sight. He knows each one of us by name. He knows the type of personality we have. He knows our likes and dislikes. He knows every little detail of our lives from the day we take our first breath of life until the day we leave this earth and enter into His Presence.

Just think about it! He has the ability to **simultaneously** hear the cry of millions upon millions of His children and at the same time He is able to minister to each one of those specific needs.

Jesus said our Father is aware of every sparrow that falls to the ground, and His children are much more valuable than the sparrows.

Are not two sparrows sold for a penny? Yet not one of them will fall to the ground apart from the will of your Father. And even the very hairs of your head are all numbered. So don't be afraid; you are worth more than many sparrows.

(Matthew 10:29-31, NIV)

Beloved, God is saying to you, "You are precious in My sight. My eyes are upon you and My ears have heard your cries."

For the eyes of the Lord are over the righteous, and his ears are open unto their prayers...

(I Peter 3:12)

God is speaking to you right now:

"My child, I have not forgotten nor forsaken you. What I have promised, that will I do. Take courage, come unto Me and find refuge and strength within My arms. Make My Word your dwelling place and habitation. Be not afraid. Have I not promised you that I will never leave you nor forsake you? Trust only in Me. My words will not pass away but they will accomplish in your life My purpose for you. If you will lean upon Me now, and doubt not that I have

spoken to you, I will give you rest from the problems that distress you and lead you into a new resting place within Me."

Rejoice in what God is going to do for you! God not only knows each one of us individually by name, but, He also deals with us individually.

Every child that is born into a family is an individual, The wise mother and father know that they must deal with that child according to his personality traits. For instance, a parent knows that it will take different types of motivation for a child who is easily motivated than one who is lazy. Different types of discipline are needed for the child who is stubborn and rebellious than for the child who is sensitive and possesses a teachable spirit.

As the parent watches his children grow and develop, he receives an understanding of how certain events will affect each child. Some children are easily discouraged, while others refuse to give up regardless of the circumstances involved.

With the same family there may be a child who is enthusiastic, full of energy and possesses a desire to achieve, as well as a child who is more reserved and achieves at a slower pace. There are children in families who have a high self-esteem, and others who are continually putting themselves down and need to be lifted up and encouraged.

In order for the parent to guide these different personalities and help them reach their full potential, they know they must develop different methods of dealing with each child **individually**. They know that it will take loving concern, patience, understanding, forgiveness, firmness and discipline to help mold their children and help them achieve their full potential.

All truth is parallel.

These same principles are true in the family of God. And when the full revelation of the heavenly Father's relationship with you, as His child, is opened up to you (remember revelation is the veil of darkness being taken away), it will be a new source of strength and will be a turning point in your life.

God knows all about you.

O LORD, thou hast searched me, and known me.

(Psalm 139:1)

He **knows** your name (John 10:3).

He **knows** your thoughts (Psalm 139:2).

He **knows** every word you speak (Psalm 139:4).

He **knows** the steps that you take (Psalm 139:2-3).

He **knows** how frail you are (Psalm 103:14).

He **knows** how much you are able to bear (I Cor. 10:13).

He **knows** what you need before you ask (Matthew 6:8).

It was this knowledge that strengthened Job **before** he reached his turning point:

But he (God) knoweth the way that I take: when he hath tried (tested) me, I shall come forth as gold.

(Job 23:10)

Job knew that God had confidence in him...that he would be victorious.

God knew Job intimately and although He considered Job to be a perfect man (Job 1:8), during this time of testing Job was purged of a spirit of self-righteousness (Job 32:1 -2; 33:8-9; 40:8). After God confronted Job, he repented and God **turned** him around and doubled his blessings.

God knows **you** intimately and because of His great love:

1. You are precious in His sight. You have been bought with the precious blood of Jesus Christ, God's only begotten Son (Isaiah 43:4, John 3:16. I Corinthians 6:20).

2. You are His new creation (II Corinthians 5:17), and you have been reconciled to God through His Son, Jesus Christ (II Corinthians 5:19).

3. You are the righteousness of God in Him (II Corinthians 5:21).

4. You are a child of the **living** God (Galatians 4:4-7).

5. You are a joint-heir with Jesus (Romans 8:17).

6. You are a partaker of His divine nature (II Peter 1:34).

7. You are an ambassador, a diplomatic agent of the highest rank; an authorized representative (II Corinthians 5:20).

8. You are a chosen generation...a royal priesthood (I Peter 2:5,9).

9. You are the **Body** of Christ (I Corinthians 12:27).

10. You are complete (nothing lacking) in Him (Colossians 2:10).

11. You are the light of the world (Matthew 5:14).

Jesus **knew** each one of His disciples intimately and dealt with each one according to their personality. In dealing with Peter, Jesus knew that although

Peter had forsaken all and followed Him faithfully that the day would come when he would deny Him three times and, following His death, that Peter would return to his fishing boat. But, praise God, He also knew what Peter needed in his life to **turn** him around. Jesus knew Peter's life would be completely transformed on the Day of Pentecost when he was baptized in the Holy Spirit.

Jesus knew that Thomas needed physical evidence of His resurrection before he would believe. When Thomas saw Jesus' nail-scarred hands and felt Jesus' side where He had been pierced by the Roman soldier's spear, he believed and it became a turning point in his life.

Although Saul had never know Jesus before his encounter on the road to Damascus, Jesus knew him. And, despite Saul's hatred and persecution of the Church, Jesus knew what it would take to change the course of his life. From the role of persecutor, he became a leading teacher; and instead of tearing down, he was used mightily of God to build the Church.

God's Dealings with His Children Are Not Always Instantaneous

So, you see, all of God's dealings with His children are not the same. He knows what method it will take for each one of us to reach our full potential in the Kingdom of God.

We are now living in what could be called an "instant" society. Man has so evolved over the years, and the pace of day-to-day living has accelerated at such a rate, until we have come to a point where we expect instantaneous solutions to our problems.

We have developed "instant" foods; "instant" credit; "instant" money (through the aid of automatic tellers); "instant" remedies (dealing with the problems of overeating, aging, smoking, etc.). As a result, many times we expect "instant" answers from God.

There are times in the lives of God's children when He instantaneously delivers those bound by habits (drugs, smoking, alcohol) and performs instantaneous healings. However, in this book, God has directed me to tell you concerning your circumstances...the problems in your finances...problems in family relationships...individual problems involving your personality...God's method of dealing with your problems is not going to necessarily mean an instantaneous miracle, but you are going to experience a turning point... a

significant change. A miracle is going to take place that is going to turn your life around.

In the vision of the hands coming out of heaven, I noticed something which will be very significant to you in the days ahead. The hands were not **jerking** the people out of the water, but they were gently picking them up and **slowly** turning them around.

As God turns you around you must remember that because of the intensity of the storm you are in, you are vulnerable and fragile. That is why God is not going to just pick you up and do an about-face with you. That is why He is going to take you and turn you slowly. So, if you are not in exactly the position you want to be, do not let it bother you.

Your position is that you know. What do you know?

You **know** that the devil is defeated.

You **know** that God is working out the circumstances in your life.

You **know** and can feel that He is positioning and strengthening you.

You **know** that day by day you are growing. You may not yet be where you want to be but it is happening.

God has a plan...a purpose...an objective for your life and He knows exactly how and what it will take to turn your life around. He also knows the time element involved.

He wants to lead you into that new dimension I spoke of earlier where you will EXPERIENCE all those things He has prepared that you have not been able to see or comprehend...that He is now beginning to reveal to us by His Spirit.

Do you want to know why God doesn't always give "instant" solutions to our problems? God knows you are fragile and if He doesn't turn you slowly, you may break under the stress and strain.

Think about it for just a moment. I am sure you would not expect your toddler to instantaneously mature over night. It would be a frustrating and frightening experience for a child to possess the maturity of an adult within the body of a two year old. Would you want your two year old to possess the strength of an adult? Of course not. It would be dangerous.

Neither does God expect His children to mature over night. He does not give us instantaneous maturity the moment we are born again. God does not fill

us instantaneously with His miracle power. So much of what God has prepared for us is so powerful..so explosive...if He just poured it into us at birth, we would not be able to contain it. We would explode!

The same principle is true in our relationship with God. You see, relationships are not instantaneous. Relationships grow and develop...they are built.

The Church of Jesus Christ which will be presented spotless and blameless before God is not an instantaneous creation. God is building us and conforming us into the image of His Son. God is working in us and through us.

*For we are labourers together with God: ye are
God's husbandry, ye are God's building.
(I Corinthians 3:9)*

This maturing process involves a day-to-day **relationship** with God.

Praise God, in this **turning point** within God's harvesttime cycle, He wants to bring you into a new **relationship** in Him.

He will bring you into a new level of strength and Christian maturity.

He will develop within you an even greater confidence and trust in Him.

He wants you to know regardless of the problems or turmoil you face that He is turning your circumstances around.

Chapter Four

"BROTHER CERULLO, How do I hear and receive the Word of the Lord?"

The first step you must take towards your turning point is to hear and receive the word of the Lord as it falls from the lips of God's servant. Many times God's children have not received all that He has for them simply because they have not received and acted upon the message He has given them.

Jacob, is a perfect example of man's reluctance to act upon God's Word. He was given the message to go back to his kindred, that God would deal well with him. Yet, his first reaction was to doubt and be fearful. His circumstances overwhelmed him and he began to be fearful. He tried to work out his own solution instead of relying on the word of God given to him by the angel.

It was not until Jacob fully accepted God's promise and received it into his spirit, that he was able to step out in faith and claim the victory.

As the realization of the promise penetrated into his spirit, he began to see there was no reason to be afraid...there was no reason to run from his circumstances. The promise God had given him began to explode within him.

He was a son of God who had been called and ordained and given power to meet the circumstances of life! He received the word and obeyed and his life was turned around. Had Jacob failed to listen, he probably would have spent the rest of his life in fear and failure.

Throughout the Bible the main link between success and failure, victory and defeat, life and death was hearing and obeying God's word. The children of Israel were given the choice to hear and obey the word of the Lord and be blessed, or to refuse to hear, disobey the word of the Lord and be cursed.

God uses His prophets to deliver the word of the Lord and the children of Israel were admonished to believe His prophets:

Surely the Lord GOD will do nothing, but he revealeth his secret unto his servants the prophets.

(Amos 3:7)

...Believe in the LORD your God, so shall ye be established; believe his

prophets, so shall ye prosper.

(II Chronicles 20:20)

Many people today hear the word that God speaks through His servants, but they take it very lightly. Some even feel that the office of a prophet is no longer needed.

While it is true that man has been restored to direct communion with God through the death and resurrection of Jesus; and through the indwelling Presence and power of the Holy Spirit, the Word of God is revealed and understood; God still uses His servants, the prophets, to speak to His people.

"BROTHER CERULLO, How do I hear and receive the Word of the Lord?"

And he gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers For the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ.

(Ephesians 4:11-12)

In this scripture there are five specific offices God has ordained for His servants to fill within the Church:

Apostles, prophets, evangelists, pastors, teachers.

All five of these were placed in the Church for a designated time period and purpose:

Till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ.

(Ephesians 4:13)

Christians readily acknowledge the role of the evangelist, pastor and teacher, but, somehow exclude the need for the apostles and prophets. However none of these are to be disregarded until the conditions set forth in this scripture are fulfilled...until the Church has grown and matured unto the stature of the fullness of Christ.

As a prophet of God, just as I admonish you not to take the words I have spoken concerning the turning point in your life lightly, I want to assure you that I do not speak them lightly.

As God's prophet, I will be held accountable for every word that I speak forth as a message from God.

In the Name of Jesus, I urge you to hear and receive the word God has

given you. Receive all that He has for you.

Allow God's promise...that He has not forsaken you, that even now He is turning your life around...to take root and grow within your **spirit**. Notice, I did not say let it grow within your mind. It must go much deeper than that.

One of the reasons why God's people are not seeing more miracles taking place in their lives is because the promises of God have become lodged within their minds. God's people **KNOW** what God has promised, they **KNOW** God's Word is true, but until it penetrates deep down into their spirits...in their inner man...it will not produce results.

We must move from a "head knowledge" relationship to an "experiential" relationship.

The moment God's promises. His revelation, take root within your spirit you are going to notice a difference. A new strength is going to manifest itself within you. You may even be amazed at your own reactions. Situations and circumstances which normally cause you to be fearful and discouraged will no longer hold you in bondage. In the midst of your circumstances and turmoil that surrounds you, you will be able to stand firm **knowing** His promises are going to become a reality in your life.

Chapter Five

"BROTHER CERULLO, How can I stay in the flow of God's harvesttime cycle?"

As I have said many times before, one of the greatest keys to harvest is spiritual timing...knowing when a supernatural breakthrough comes to God's people...so that NOTHING will hinder you from receiving all that God has for you.

One of the first manifestations that is going to take place in God's harvest-time cycle is:

God is going to have a people. people who practice what they preach. No longer are God's people going to say one thing and live another. Too many Christians today say they believe in God's power to heal...to deliver...to provide...yet when Satan attacks their circumstances they fail to activate their faith to receive the answers they need from God.

In this cycle, God is turning this situation around. He is going to have a people who not only believe the promises God has made to them over the years, but people who are beginning to **experience** the fullness of those promises as they begin to reap the blessings of God.

In order to enjoy the endtime blessings He is pouring out, you must "get in step" with the moving of God's Spirit. When God speaks, put your faith into action. Remember, **faith is a fact, but faith is an act.**

It would be a terrible thing for either of the following two possibilities to take place in your life:

1. To hear about what God has for you and not to partake of it.
2. To see God manifesting Himself in the lives of others, but not being able to partake of it.

Stay in the flow of the events that are taking place in the lives of God's people during this harvest-time cycle.

Expect a Miracle to Take Place in Your Circumstances

God has promised to turn your life around. After you receive this promise into your spirit, and enter into the flow of God's harvest-time cycle, begin to

EXPECT the miracle you need in your life.

A miracle is something that cannot happen by human means.

Beloved, something is happening! A spirit of expectancy is beginning to fall upon the Body of Christ. Believers are beginning to sense that something great is about to happen. We are on the verge of the greatest outpouring of God's Spirit the world has ever known. The glory of God is going to be manifested among His children and we are going to live in a new realm of His miracle-working power.

Even now as you read, I pray that a spirit of expectancy will come upon you to receive the miracle you need from God in your circumstances...either in your physical body, in your spiritual life, in your family life, or in your finances.

You can prepare yourself to receive this miracle as you begin to take your eyes off your circumstances and your conditions, and as you begin to focus them on the bigness of God. When you lose sight of your circumstances, you begin to see the bigness of God.

As you begin to expect the miracle you need for your turning point, remember that God has shown me that He is going to turn the circumstances in your life around slowly. I believe in this turning process there may be a progression of miracles which will bring you into the relationship God wants you to have.

Remember what God spoke to me as He told me to take my eyes off the bigness of my circumstances:

God said, "I will take you step by step by step...not all at once...and each step will be a miracle."

What type of miracle do you need? As you look beyond your immediate circumstances...your need...put your faith into action and begin to **praise** Him for your miracle...your turning point.

Refuse to accept your situation as it is. Now, don't think I am telling you to run from your circumstances like Jacob did, or to hide out in the desert like Elijah. I am telling you to face those circumstances "head-on" with a spirit of expectancy. Each day expect and begin to praise God for a miracle.

When God's promise has taken root within your spirit you will be able to say:

"Praise God, regardless of what comes my way today, I **know** God's hand

is upon my life and **nothing** can move me. The Lord is going to deliver me from every evil work, and will preserve me (II Timothy 4:18). I am believing God for a miracle and I praise Him now for what He is going to do in my life!"

... I know whom I have believed, and am persuaded that he is able to keep that which I have committed unto him against that day.

(II Timothy 1:12)

As God begins to work in your life, become more sensitive to His miracle-working power He has placed within you. As His Spirit moves upon you, release that miracle-working power in accordance with His Word.

God wants you to live in a rhythm of victory miracle living. He not only wants you to **expect a miracle** in your life, He wants you to **expect God to perform His miracle-working power through you.**

Fix Your Faith on the Infallible Word of God

So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it.

(Isaiah 55:11)

The word God has spoken to you will not return unto Him void. The promises He has made to you **will** come to pass!

Now that you have received the word of God to you that this is your **turning point**, enter into the harvest-time cycle and expect miracles to flow in and through you. There is only one more step for you to take which will assure you of victory...you must have a fixed point of your faith.

That fixed point is the Word of God.

The Bible is the written Word of God. It is our guide; it is our resting place. It is the voice of God giving us direction for our lives, our businesses, our homes. It is the foundation that standeth sure though the heavens and earth be shaken.

The Word of God is eternal, secure, immutable. It is our fixed point for our faith which is both infallible and impregnable. The word "infallible" means "no margin for error." It means "absolutely incapable of making a mistake," "impossible to deceive...incapable of misleading."

The Word of God has absolute authority for us in the midst of every circumstance, every problem, every distress, every sickness, every need. It is

infallible. It is unshakable. It is unassailable.

The Word is the logos, the Living Word; and it is also the Rhema, the written Word. You cannot separate the two.

When you fix your faith to the written Word, you are fixing your faith to God, the Living Word.

God gave me another word. He said, "Son, tell My people to fix their faith, not only to that which is infallible but also to that which is impregnable."

The word "impregnable" means "incapable of being taken by assault."

In your mind, picture yourself in a fortress. Here comes the enemy. He is attacking you and bombarding you. He is putting his atomic bombs in his aircraft and coming against you from every different direction. Here you are inside...

IF YOU HAVE YOUR FAITH FIXED TO THAT WRITTEN AND LIVING WORD, YOU ARE ABSOLUTELY INCAPABLE OF BEING CONQUERED.

If you will walk forward with your faith firmly fixed on God and His Word, with a heart full of confidence knowing that He is going to turn your life around, you are going to see a decisive change take place. And, beloved, **it is only the beginning** of what God is going to do for you.

A new peace is going to surround you as a new confidence in God and His Word begins to take root and grow within you.

And this is the confidence that we have in him, that, if we ask any thing according to his will, he heareth us:

And if we know that he hear us, whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we desired of him.

(1 John 5:14-15)

You may not be able to see the answer or solution to your problem...you may still feel some pain and discomfort. But these are temporary, outward circumstances. You now **know** how God deals with His children, and as you feel the strength of His everlasting arms around you...the deep inner assurance of your relationship...turning and positioning you, you are going to be unshakable...unmovable...by the circumstances in your life. You will have victory to overcome.

God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble. Therefore

will not we fear, though the earth be removed, and though the mountains be carried into the midst of the sea; Though the waters thereof roar and be troubled, though the mountains shake with the swelling thereof...

(Psalm 46:1-3)

God is going to lift you up above the storm and plant your feet on solid ground. God is going to restore to you **double** and you are going to partake of the unsearchable riches of His glory.

This is God's turning point for your life.

Believe it...

Act on it...

Live in it...NOW. It's harvest time!
